**DROUGHT WATCH ADVISORY FOR CUSTOMERS**

**Effective August 13, 2012**

Lack of rainfall has decreased available groundwater. This drought watch requests a voluntary 5 % reduction in water usage. This situation may change in the near future requiring mandatory restrictions. Announcements will be posted on public bulletin boards, Borough website and possible mailings to customers.

Things you can do as a customer to voluntarily reduce water use by 5%

Check for leaks in your household.

Take short showers instead of baths.

Run dishwasher and washing machine only with full loads.

Reduce water used for pavement and car washing.

Where possible, use rain collected water to water gardens.

With everyone reducing water use by 5%, the town can save

115,000 gallons a month.
