

MINUTES
Bloomfield Borough Council
November 28, 2011

Bloomfield Borough Council met this evening in special session for the purpose of a public hearing in the Bloomfield Borough Council Chambers with the following Council members present: President Pierce L. Clouser, Jr., Leroy J. Weller, Karl L. Cless, Edwin G. Robinson and Jayne M. Eckert. Vice President Long and Councilman Patterson excused absence.

Also present: Borough Secretary Nancy Pote, Nancy Stahley, Burt Clouser and Robert I. Hench.

President Clouser called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

President Clouser stated that the purpose of the public hearing is to rezone the rear portion of parcel #020,086.04-191.000 located at 218 South Carlisle Street from R-1 to C-1 and no other business will be conducted at this meeting. President Clouser further stated that the meeting was properly advertised, property posted and adjacent property owners were notified by certified mail.

President Clouser stated that any guest that wishes to speak should announce their name, physical location of residence and state the purpose of their being here for the rezoning location only.

President Clouser further stated that the ordinance relative to this matter has been properly advertised and will be considered for adoption at our regular December meeting.

President Clouser requested if anyone wishes to speak. Hearing none, he stated for the record that four adjoining property owners were present at the meeting.

Councilman Robinson made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman Eckert, to rezone the rear portion of 218 South Carlisle Street from R-1 to C-1. Councilman Cless abstained due to his involvement in this project. Motion carried.

There being no further business, upon motion by Councilwoman Eckert, seconded by Councilman Weller, meeting adjourned to meet on Tuesday, December 6, 2011. Motion carried.
