

BUDGET MINUTES
Bloomfield Borough Council
October 11, 2021

Bloomfield Borough Council met this evening in the Bloomfield Borough Council Chambers in special session for the purpose of budget and any other business that may come before Council with the following Council members present: President Malinda C. Anderson, Vice President J. Kevin Fitzpatrick, Michael J. Smith, Brenten S. Dum, Kimberly A. McMullen, James A. Woods, and Jessica L. Grindle.

Also present: Borough Secretary Danielle Shope

President Anderson called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Recording of the Meeting – President Anderson reported that except for the budget discussion, the meeting is being recorded for the accuracy of the minutes.

2022 Budget - Council spent the evening comparing figures, determining projects that will be completed in 2022 and adding/deleting classifications as needed.

Vice President Fitzpatrick made a motion, seconded by Councilman Smith to increase the Mayor's salary to \$1,200 per year beginning in January 2022. Motion carried.

There being no further business, upon motion by Councilman Smith, seconded by Vice President Fitzpatrick, the meeting adjourned at 8:53 p.m. to meet on Tuesday, November 2, 2021 for the regularly scheduled meeting. Motion carried.

The Budget meeting, upon motion by Vice President Fitzpatrick, seconded by Councilman Smith, was reopened at 8:55 p.m. to discuss a few other issues. Motion carried.

Vice President Fitzpatrick made a motion, seconded by Councilwoman McMullen, to increase the salary of Borough employees for budget purposes by 3% beginning in January 2022. It was also moved to increase the hours for the Parking Enforcement Officer up to 25 hours per month and to increase the hours for the Borough Code Enforcement Officer up to 12 hours per week. Motion carried.

There being no further business, upon motion by Vice President Fitzpatrick, seconded by Councilman Woods, the budget meeting adjourned at 8:57 p.m. to meet on Tuesday, November 2, 2021 for the regularly scheduled meeting. Motion carried.
